

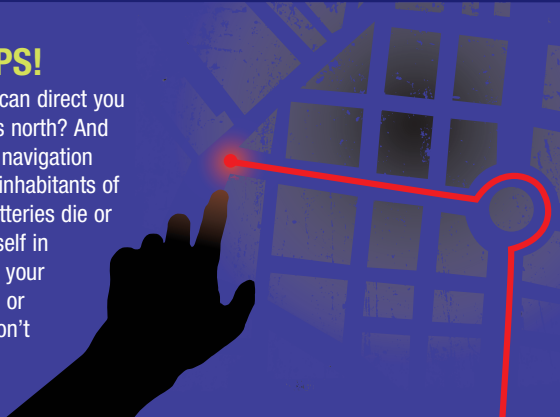

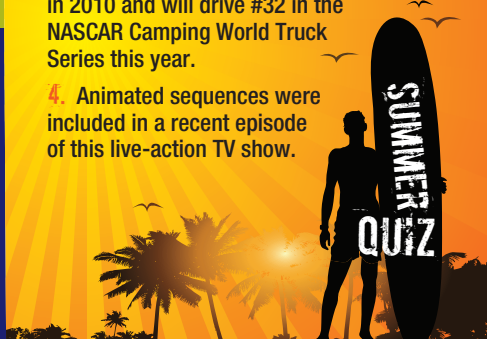


**AN OLD TALE**
